

Joan Kalish Scholarship 2019

This scholarship honors Joan C. Kalish, a Spanish teacher in the Plymouth Canton Community School System, until her passing on February 9, 2019. Her love for her students, her compassion for all, her creativity, and her diligence in seeing every student succeed is her legacy. Her family wishes to extend this assistance to one of her students so that her memory will have a more tangible impact.

Purpose

This one-time scholarship is established to provide post-secondary financial assistance to a 2019 graduating Senior of the Plymouth Canton Community School District, who benefitted from Joan Kalish's dedication to teaching.

Amount to be awarded

The amount to be awarded is dependent upon contributions made to this fund by family members and others, between its establishment and the date of the award. The amount will be announced at the time of the award.

Criteria

- Minimum GPA of 2.0
- Recipient must have been enrolled in at least one class with Joan as the teacher, during the 2018-19 school year or a previous year of enrollment in the P-CCS system.
- Recipient must provide evidence of acceptance and enrolment in a post-secondary institution. The student's major does not need to be in the area of World Languages.

- Essay of approximately 500 words noting the impact of Ms. Kalish's teaching on the applicant's academic and career plans
- Two letters of recommendation
