- Must have a 2.5 cumulative grade point average
- Must use scholarship funds for post-secondary education
- Must submit an application accompanied with
 - Your high school transcript
 - Proof of acceptance to college/university/technical school (award check will not be distributed without proof of acceptance sent to EEF office)
 - Two letters of recommendation
 - one from a teacher or counselor
 - one from an employer, pastor, mentor or neighbor but not a relative
